

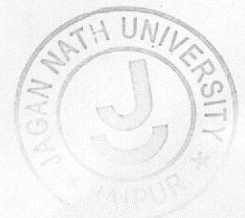

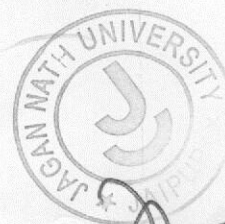

Ensure that practical courses are adequately integrated with the theoretical ones to enhance the learning experience for all students.
2.	The courses have applicability to real-life problems	Incorporate more real-world case studies, simulations, and industry-based projects into the course curriculum. Engage industry experts to provide guest lectures or mentorship for students to bridge the gap between theory and practice.
3.	The courses provide hands-on learning in terms of skills and abilities	Enhance opportunities for hands-on learning, such as lab work, internships, and live projects. Collaborate with industry partners to create practical experiences that directly align with course content, allowing students to develop key skills.
4.	Lab manuals are available	Ensure that lab manuals are consistently updated and easily accessible for all students. If any courses lack lab manuals or have outdated ones, these should be revised or developed to ensure they meet current academic and practical needs.
5.	The electives offered are of relevance to the specialization streams	Review and update the elective options to ensure they better align with the current trends and demands of the specialization streams. Value added Courses also offered to the students.

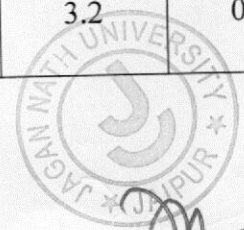

4	Offer more scholarships and financial aid for deserving students.	The university has expanded its scholarship programs and introduced need-based financial aid schemes to support deserving students.



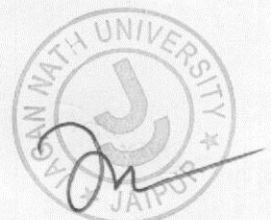
