Claim

University follows the State Government Policy for Reservation of Seats for SC, ST, OBC, SBC& EBC in various programs. A student applying for reserved category has to submit Category Certificate as proof. Since the number of students applying against reserved categories has generally been lower than the number of seats available, all eligible students fulfilling criteria get admission. The seats remaining vacant against reservation category are filled from general category candidates. All the data as per the template for number of students admitted from reserved category and total number of seats earmarked for reserved category as per State Government Policy has been attached. Further copy of the State Government Reservation Policy, sample admission form for reserve category students, abstract of University Admission policy regarding reservation of seats, resolution of Board of Management for the last five years are attached.

Further the data regarding the admission made against reserved categories are submitted to the department of Higher Education, Government of Rajasthan every year and abstract of the same for last five years have been uploaded along with other documents. In view of the systematic and transparent system adopted by the University, full credit under metric 2.1.2 is claimed.
