



Claim Sheet

The University has adopted the UGC guidelines relating to redressal of student grievances including sexual harassment and ragging cases. All the policy documents relating to prevention of sexual harassment, Vishaka guidelines against sexual harassment, Anti ragging Committee, Grievance Redressal Mechanism, Women Development Cell and Minority cell have been uploaded. The UGC posters on anti ragging have been displaced on all the prominent places in the campus. The University has been organizing workshop, lectures and other activities for creating awareness on all the polices. There is an online and offline mechanism for submission of student grievances which are timely resolved through appropriate committees. All the relevant documents including policies, anti ragging posters, activities organize to create awareness, online/offline mechanism for submission of grievances; details of committees' constitution etc. are attached. Keeping in view of comprehensive framework and process adopted to redress student's grievances the University claims full score in this metric.



(University Grants Commission) NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 2nd May, 2016

University Grants Commission (Prevention, prohibition and redressal of sexual harassment of women employees and students in higher educational institutions) Regulations, 2015

No. F. 91-1/2013(TFGS).—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (g) of sub-section (1) of section 26 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 (3 of 1956), read with sub-section (1) of Section 20 of the said Act, the University Grants Commission hereby makes the following regulations, namely:-

- Short title, application and commencement.—(1) These regulations may be called the University Grants Commission (Prevention, prohibition and redressal of sexual harassment of women employees and students in higher educational institutions) Regulations, 2015.
 - (2) They shall apply to all higher educational institutions in India.
 - (3) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- Definitions.—In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires,-
- (a) "aggrieved woman" means in relation to work place, a woman of any age whether employed or not when alleges to have been subjected to any act of sexual harassment by the respondent;
- (b) 'Act' means the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 (14 of 2013);
- (c) "campus" means the location or the land on which a Higher Educational Institution and its related institutional facilities like libraries, laboratories, lecture halls, residences, halls, toilets, student centres, hostels, dining halls, stadiums, parking areas, parks-like settings and other amenities like health centres, canteens, Bank counters, etc., are situated and also includes extended campus and covers within its scope places visited as a student of the HEI including transportation provided for the purpose of commuting to and from the institution, the locations outside the institution on field trips, internships, study tours, excursions, short-term placements, places used for camps, cultural f-stivals, sports meets and such other activities where a person is participating in the capacity of an employee or a student of the HEI;

- (द) अधिदेशात्मक परामर्श अथवा सामुदायिक सेवाओं जैसे सुधारवादी दण्ड प्रदान करना;
- (3) पीडित व्यक्ति मुआवजे का अधिकारी है। आन्तरिक शिकायत समिति द्वारा अनुशंसित तथा कार्यकारी प्राधिकारी द्वारा स्वीकृत मुआवजे के भुगतान के लिए उच्चतर शैक्षिक संस्थान निर्देश जारी करेगा, जिसकी वसूली अपराधकर्ता से की जाएगी। देय मुआवजे का निर्धारण निम्न आधार पर होगा:-
 - (अ) पीड़ित व्यक्ति को जितना मानसिक तनाव, कच्ट, व्यथा एवं दुख पहुँचा है;
 - (ब) उस लैंगिक उत्पीड़न की घटना के कारण उन्हें अपनी जीविका के सुअवसर की हानि उठानी पड़ी;
 - (स) पीडित व्यक्ति द्वारा अपने शारीरिक एवं मनोरोग संबंधी आधार के लिए खर्च किए गए विकित्सा व्ययः
 - (द) कथित अपराधकर्ता एवं उस पीड़ित व्यक्ति की आय एवं जीवन स्तर, और
 - (ई) ऐसे समस्त भूगतान का एकमुश्त रूप से या किस्तों में किए जाने का औचित्य:

11. झुठी विकायत के विरुद्ध कार्यवाई-

इस बात को सुनिश्चित करने के लिए कि लैंगिक उत्पोद्धन मामलों में कर्मधारियों एवं छात्रों की सुरक्षा के प्रायधानों का दुरुपयोग न हो, असत्य एवं द्वेष भावना पूर्ण शिकायतों के विरुद्ध प्रावधान किये जाने की आवश्यकता है तथा इन्हें उच्चतर शैक्षिक संस्थानों में प्रचारित प्रसारित किया जाना चाहिए। आन्तरिक शिकायत समिटि यदि यह निष्कर्य निकालती है कि लगाए गए अभियोग असत्य, थे, विद्वेषपूर्ण थे अथवा यह जानते हुए भी कि वह शिकायत असत्य अथवा जाली है अथवा भ्रामक सूचना को उस पड़ताल के दौरान उपलब्ध कराया गया है तो शिकायतकर्ता विनियम (10) के उप विनियम (1) के तहत दण्डित किये जाने के लिए बाह्य होगा यदि शिकायतकर्ता एक कर्मचारी है, तथा यदि वह अपराधकर्ता एक छात्र है तो वह इस विनियम की उप-विनियम (2) के प्रावधानों के अनुसार सजा के लिए बाह्य होगा तथापि किसी भी शिकायत को प्रमाणित करने अथवा उसके लिए पर्याप्त सबूत उपलब्ध न कर पाने का आधार, शिकायतकर्ता के विरुद्ध कार्रवाई करने का कारण नहीं माना जा सकता है। शिकायतकर्ता द्वारा देवपूर्ण उद्देश्य से दावर शिकायत की जाँच पढ़ताल द्वारा तय किया जाना चाहिए तथा इस बारे में किसी कार्रवाई की सिकारिश किए जाने से पूर्व इस विषय में निधारित प्रणाली के अनुसार जाँच की जानी चाहिए;

12. गैर अनुपालन के परिणाम:-

- (1) ऐसे संस्थान जो जानबूझकर अथवा बारंबार उन दायित्वों तथा कर्तव्यों के अनुपालन में असमर्थ बना रहता है जिन्हें कर्मचारियों एवं छात्रों के प्रति लैंगिक उत्पीड़न के निराकरण, निषेध एवं समाधान हेतु निर्धारित किया गया है, तो इस स्थिति में आयोग विधिवत नोटिस देकर निम्न में से किसी एक अथवा इससे अधिक बिन्दुओं पर कार्रवाई करेगा:-
 - (अ) विश्वविद्यालय अनुदान आयोग अधिनियम 1956 की धारा 12(बी) के अन्तर्गत की गई घोषणा जो पात्रता दिये जाने के विषय में है, उसका आहरण किया जाना;
 - (व) आयोग द्वारा अधिनियम 1956 की धारा 2 (एफ) के अन्तर्गत अनुरक्षित सूची में से उस विश्वविद्यालय अथवा महाविद्यालय का नाम हटाना;
 - (स) संस्थान को आबंटित किसी भी अनुदान को रोक देना,
 - आयोग को किसी भी सामान्य अथवा विशेष सहायता कार्यक्रमों के अन्तर्गत किसी भी सहायता को प्राप्त करने के लिए उस संस्थान को अपात्र घोषित किया जाना;
 - (ई) जन साधारण को, एवं रोजगार अध्या प्रदेश के इथ्छुक मात्री प्रत्याशियों को एक ऐसे मोटिस द्वारा सूचित करना जो समाचार पत्रों में प्रमुख रूप से दर्शाया गया है अथवा उपयुक्त मीडिया में दर्शाया गया है तथा आयोग की वेबसाइट पर प्रदर्शित किया गया है तथा जिस नोटिस में घोषणा की गई है कि वह संस्थान लैंगिक जत्पीड़न के विरुद्ध शून्य सहनशीलता नीति नित्रव जवसनतंदबम चवसपबलद्ध का समर्थन नहीं करता है:
 - (एफ) यदि वह एक महाविधालय है तो उसके सम्बद्ध विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा उसकी सहसम्बद्धता को आहरित करने की अनुशंसा के लिये कहें;



- (d) Commission" means the University Grants Commission established under section 4 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 (3 of 1956);
- (e) "covered individuals" are persons who have engaged in protected activity such as filing a sexual harassment charge, or who are closely associated with an individual who has engaged in protected activity and such person can be an employee or a fellow student or guardian of the offended person;
- (f) "employee" means a person as defined in the Act and also includes, for the purposes of these Regulations trainee, apprentice (or called by any other name), interns, volunteers, teacher assistants, research assistants, whether employed or not, including those involved in field studies, projects, short-visits and camps;
- (g) "Executive Authority" means the chief executive authority of the HEI, by whatever name called, in which the general administration of the HEI is vested. For public funded institutions the Executive Authority means the Disciplinary Authority as indicated in Central Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1965 or its equivalent rules;
- (h) "Higher Educational Institution" (HEI) means a university within the meaning of clause (j) of section 2, a college within the meaning of clause(b) of sub-section (1) of section 12A and an institution deemed to be a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 (3 of 1956);
- (i) "Internal Complaints Committee" (ICC) means Internal Complaints Committee to be constituted by an HEI under sub regulation (1) of regulation 4 of these regulations. Any existing body already functioning with the same objective (like the Gender Sensitization Committee Against Sexual Harassment (GSCASH)) should be reconstituted as the ICC:
 - Provided that in the latter case the HEI shall ensure that the constitution of such a Body is as required for ICC under these regulations. Provided further that such a Body shall be bound by the provisions of these regulations;
- "protected activity" includes reasonable opposition to a practice believed to violate sexual harassment laws on behalf of oneself or others such as participation in sexual harassment proceedings, cooperating with an internal investigation or alleged sexual harassment practices or acting as a witness in an investigation by an outside agency or in litigation;
- (k) "sexual harassment" means-
 - (i) "An unwanted conduct with sexual undertones if it occurs or which is persistent and which demeans, humiliates or creates a hostile and intimidating environment or is calculated to induce submission by actual or threatened adverse consequences and includes any one or more or all of the following unwelcome acts or behaviour (whether directly or by implication), namely;-
 - (a) any unwelcome physical, verbal or non verbal conduct of sexual nature;
 - (b) demand or request for sexual favours;
 - (c) making sexually coloured remarks
 - (d) physical contact and advances; or
 - (e) showing pornography"
 - (ii) any one (or more than one or all) of the following circumstances, if it occurs or is present in relation or connected with any behaviour that has explicit or implicit sexual undertones-
 - implied or explicit promise of preferential treatment as quid pro quo for sexual favours;
 - (b) implied or explicit threat of detrimental treatment in the conduct of work;
 - implied or explicit threat about the present or future status of the person concerned;
 - (d) creating an intimidating offensive or hostile learning environment;
 - humiliating treatment likely to affect the health; safety dignity or physical integrity of the person concerned;



- (1) "student" means a person duly admitted and pursuing a programme of study either through regular mode or distance mode, including short-term training programmes in a HEI; Provided that a student who is in the process of taking admission in HEIs campus, although not yet admitted, shall be treated, for the purposes of these regulations, as a student of that HEI, where any incident of sexual harassment takes place against such student; Provided that a student who is a participant in any of the activities in a HEI other than the HEI where such student is enrolled shall be treated, for the purposes of these regulations, as a student of that HEI where any incident of sexual harassment takes place against such student;
- (m) "third Party Harassment" refers to a situation where sexual harassment occurs as a result of an act or omission by any third party or outsider, who is not an employee or a student of the HEL but a visitor to the HEL in some other capacity or for some other purpose or eason;
- (n) "victimisation" means any unfavourable treatment meted out to a person with an implicit or explicit intention to obtain sexual favour;
- (o) "workplace" means the campus of a HEI including-
 - (a) Any department, organisation, undertaking, establishment, enterprise, institution, office, branch or unit which is established, owned, controlled or wholly or substantially financed by funds provided directly or indirectly by the appropriate HEIs;
 - (b) Any sports institute, stadium, sports complex or competition or games venue, whether residential or not used for training, sports or other activities relating thereof in HEIs;
 - (c) Any place visited by the employee or student arising out of or during the course of employment or study including transportation provided by the Executive Authority for undertaking such journey for study in HEIs.'
- 3. Responsibilities of the Higher Educational Institution- (1) Every HEI shall,-
- (a) Wherever required, appropriately subsume the spirit of the above definitions in its policy and regulations on prevention and prohibition of sexual harassment against the employees and the students, and modify its ordinances and rules in consonance with the requirements of the Regulations;
- (b) publicly notify the provisions against sexual harassment and ensuretheir wide dissemination;
- (c) organise training programmes or as the case may be, workshops for the officers, functionaries, faculty and students, as indicated in the SAKSHAM Report (Measures for Ensuring the Safety of Women and Programmes for Gender Sensitization on Campuses) of the Commission, to sensitize them and ensure knowledge and awareness of the rights, entitlements and responsibilities enshrined in the Act and under these regulations;
- (d) act decisively against all gender based violence perpetrated against employees and students of all sexes recognising that primarily women employees and students and some male students and students of the third gender are vulnerable to many forms of sexual barussment and humiliation and exploitation;
- (e) publicly commit itself to a zero tolerance policy towards sexual harassment;
- reinforce its commitment to creating its campus free from discrimination, harassment, retaliation or sexual assault at all levels;
- (g) create awareness about what constitutes sexual harassment including hostile environment harassment and quid pro quo harassment;
- (h) include in its prospectus and display prominently at conspicuous places or Notice Boards the penalty and consequences of sexual harassitent and make all sections of the institutional companies aware of the information on the overhanism put in place for redressal of complaints pertaining to sexual larger Nath University as put in place for redressal of complaints pertaining to sexual

harassment, contact details of members of Internal Complaints Committee, complaints procedure and so on. Any existing body already functioning with the same objective (like the Gender Sensitization Committee Against Sexual Harassment (GSCASH)) should be reconstituted as the ICC; Provided that in the latter case the HEI shall ensure that the constitution of such a Body is as required for ICC under these regulations. Provided further that such a Body shall be bound by the provisions of these regulations;


- inform employees and students of the recourse available to them if they are victims of sexual harassment;
- organise regular orientation or training programmes for the members of the ICC to deal with complaints, steer the process of settlement or conciliation, etc., with sensitivity;
- (k) proactively move to curb all forms of harassment of employees and students whether it is from those
 in a dominant power or hierarchical relationship within HEIs or owing to intimate partner violence or
 from peers or from elements outside of the geographical limits of the HEI;
- be responsible to bring those guilty of sexual harassment against its employees and students to book and initiate all proceedings as required by law and also put in place mechanisms and redressal systems like the ICC to curb and prevent sexual harassment on its campus;
- (m) treat sexual harassment as a misconduct under service rules and initiate action for misconduct if the perpetrator is an employee;
- (n) treat sexual harassment as a violation of the disciplinary rules (leading up to rustication and expulsion) if the perpetrator is a student;
- ensure compliance with the provisions of these regulations, including appointment of ICC, within a period of sixty days from the date of publication of these regulations;
- (p) monitor the timely submission of reports by the ICC:
- (q) prepare an annual status report with details on the number of cases filed and their disposal and submit the same to the Commission.
- 3.2 Supportive measures.—(1) The rules, regulations or any such other instrument by which ICC shall function have to be updated and revised from time-to-time, as court judgments and other laws and rules will continue to revise the legal framework within which the Act is to be implemented.
 - (2) The Executive Authority of the HEIs must mandatorily extend full support to see that the recommendations of the ICC are implemented in a timely manner. All possible institutional resources must be given to the functioning of the ICC, including office and building infrastructure (computers, photocopiers, audio-video, equipment, etc.), staff (typists, counselling and legal services) as, well as a sufficient allocation of financial resources.
 - (3) Vulnerable groups are particularly prone to harassment and also find it more difficult to complain. Vulnerability can be socially compounded by region, class, caste, sexual orientation, minority identity and by being differently abled. Enabling committees must be sensitive to such vulnerabilities and special needs.
 - (4) Since research students and doctoral candidates are particularly vulnerable the HEIs must ensure that the guidelines for ethics for Research Supervision are put in place.

(5) All HEIs must conduct a regular and half yearly review of the efficacy and implementation of their anti-sexual harassment policy.

- (6) All Academic Staff Colleges (now known asHuman Resource Development Centres (HRDCs) and Regional Centres for Capacity Building (RCCBs) must incorporate sessions on gender in their orientation and refresher courses. This should be across disciplines, and preferably mainstreamed using the UGC SAKSHAM Report which provides indicative modules in this regard.
- (7) Orientation courses for administrators conducted in HEIs must have a module on gender sensitization and sexual harassment issues. Regular workshops are to be conducted for all sections of the HEI community.
- (8) Counselling services must be institutionalised in all HEIs and must have well trained full-time counsellors.
- (9) Many HEIs having large campuses have a deficit in lighting and are experienced as unsafe places by the institutional community. Adequate lighting is a necessary aspect of infrastructure and maintenance.
- (10) Adequate and well trained security including a good proportion or balance of women security staff is necessary. Security staff must receive gender sensitization training as a part of conditions of appointment.
- (11) HEIs must ensure reliable public transport, especially within large campuses between different sections of the HEI, hostels, libraries, laboratories and main buildings, and especially those that do not have good access for day scholars. Lack of safety as well as harassment is exacerbated when employees and students cannot depend on safe public transport. Reliable transport may be considered by HEIs to enable employees and students to work late in libraries, laboratories and to attend programmes in the evenings.
- (12) Residential HEIs should accord priority to construction of women's hostels. For the growing population of young women wishing to access higher education, hostel accommodation is desirable in both urban and rural areas and at all levels of higher education which provides a modicum of protection from harassment of all kinds.
- (13) Concern for the safety of women students must not be cited to impose discriminatory rules for women in the hostels as compared to male students. Campus safety policies should not result in securitization, such as over monitoring or policing or curtailing the freedom of movement, especially for women employees and students.
- (14) Adequate health facilities are equally mandatory for all HEIs. In the case of women this must include gender sensitive doctors and nurses, as well as the services of a gynaecologist.
- (15) The Women's Development Cells in colleges shall be revived and funded to be able to carry out the range of activities required for gender sensitizationand remain autonomous of the functioning of anti-sexual harassment committees and ICCs. At the same time they shall extend their activities to include gender sensitization programmes in consultation with ICCs and help to disseminate antisexual harassment policies on campuses on a regular basis. The 'cultural' space and the 'formal academic space' need to collaborate to render these workshops innovative, engaging and nonmechanical.
- (16) Hostel Wardens, Provosts, Principals, Vice Chancellors, Legal Officers and other functionaries must be brought within the domain of accountability through amendments in the rules or Ordinances where necessary.
- 4. Grievance redressal mechanism.—(1) Every Executive Authority shall constitute an Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) with an inbuilt mechanism for gender sensitization against sexual harassment. The ICC shall have the following composition:-



(a) A Presiding Officer who shall be a woman faculty member employed at a senior level (not below a Professor in case of a university, and not below an Associate Professor or Reader in case of a college) at the educational institution, nominated by the Executive Authority;

Provided that in case a senior level woman employee is not available, the Presiding Officer shall be nominated from other offices or administrative units of the workplace referred to in sub-section 2(o);

Provided further that in case the other offices or administrative units of the workplace do not have a senior level woman employee, the Presiding Officer shall be nominated from any other workplace of the same employer or other department or organization;"

- (b) two faculty members and two non-teaching employees, preferably committed to the cause of women or who have had experience in social work or have legal knowledge, nominated by the Executive Authority;
- (c) Three students, if the matter involves students, who shall be enrolled at the undergraduate, master's, and research scholar levels respectively, elected through transparent democratic procedure;
- (d) one member from amongst non-government organisations or associations committed to the cause of women or a person familiar with the issues relating to sexual harassment, nominated by the Executive Authority.
- At least one-half of the total members of the ICC shall be women.
- (3) Persons in senior administrative positions in the HEL such as Vice- Chancellor, Pro Vice- Chancellors, Rectors, Registrar, Deans, Heads of Departments, etc., shall not be members of ICCs in order to ensure autonomy of their functioning.
- (4) The term of office of the members of the ICC shall be for a period of three years. HEIs may also employ a system whereby one –third of the members of the ICC may change every year.
- (5) The Member appointed form amongst the non-governmental organizations or associations shall be paid such fees or allowances for holding the proceedings of the Internal Committee, by the Executive Authority as may be prescribed.
- (6) Where the Presiding Officer or any member of the Internal Committee:
 - (a) contravenes the provisions of section 16 of the Act; or
 - (b) has been convicted for an offence or an inquiry into an offence under any law for the time being in force is pending against him; or
 - he has been found guilty in any disciplinary proceedings or a disciplinary proceeding is pending against him; or
 - (d) has so abused his position as to render his continuance in office prejudicial to the public interest,

such Presiding Officer or Member, as the case may be, shall be removed from the Committee and the vacancy so created or any casual vacancy shall be filled by fresh nomination in accordance with the provisions of this section."

Responsibilities of Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) - The Internal Complaints Committee shall:

(a) provide assistance if an employee or a student chooses to file a complaint with the police;

- (b) provide mechanisms of dispute redressal and dialogue to anticipate and address issues through just and fair conciliation without undermining complainant's rights, and minimize the need for purely punitive approaches that lead to further resentment, alienation or violence;
- (c) protect the safety of the complainant by not divulging the person's identity, and provide the mandatory relief by way of sanctioned leave or relaxation of attendance requirement or transfer to another department or supervisor as required during the pendency of the complaint, or also provide for the transfer of the offender;
- ensure that victims or witnesses are not victimised or discriminated against while dealing with complaints of sexual harassment; and
- (e) ensure prohibition of retaliation or adverse action against a covered individual because the employee or the student is engaged in protected activity.
- 6. The process for making complaint and conducting Inquiry The ICC shall comply with the procedure prescribed in these Regulations and the Act, for making a complaint and inquiring into the complaint in a time bound manner. The HEI shall provide all necessary facilities to the ICC to conduct the inquiry expeditiously and with required privacy
- 7. Process of making complaint of sexual harassment An aggrieved person is required to submit a written complaint to the ICC within three months from the date of the incident and in case of a series of incidents within a period of three months from the date of the last incident.

Provided that where such complaint cannot be made in writing, the Presiding Officer or any Member of the Internal Committee shall render all reasonable assistance to the person for making the complaint in writing.

Provided further that the ICC may, for the reasons to be accorded in the writing, extend the time limit not exceeding three months, if it is satisfied that the circumstances were such which prevented the person from filing a complaint within the said period."

Friends, relatives, Colleagues, Co-students, Psychologist, or any other associate of the victim may file the complaint in situations where the aggrieved person is unable to make a complaint on account of physical or mental in capacity or death.

- Process of conducting Inquiry- (1) The ICC shall, upon receipt of the complaint, send one copy of the complaint to the respondent within a period of seven days of such receipt.
- (2) Upon receipt of the copy of the complaint, the respondent shall file his or her reply to the complaint along with the list of documents, and names and addresses of witnesses within a period of ten days.
- (3) The inquiry has to be completed within a period of ninety days from the receipt of the complaint. The inquiry report, with recommendations, if any, has to be submitted within ten days from the completion of the inquiry to the Executive Authority of the HEL Copy of the findings or recommendations shall also be served on both parties to the complaint.
- (4) The Executive Authority of the HEI shall act on the recommendations of the committee within a period of thirty days from the receipt of the inquiry report, unless an appeal against the findings is filed within that time by either party.
- (5) An appeal against the findings or /recommendations of the ICC may be filed by either party before the Executive Authority of the HEI within a period of thirty days from the date of the recommendations.
- (6) If the Executive Authority of the HEI decides not to act as per the recommendations of the ICC, then it shall record written reasons for the same to be conveyed to ICC and both the parties to the proceedings. If on the other hand it is decided to act as per the recommendations of the ICC, then a show cause notice, answerable within ten days, shall be served on the party against whom action is decided to be taken. The Executive Authority of the HEI shall proceed only after considering the reply or hearing the aggrieved person.

The ascree of party may seek conciliation in order to settle the matter. No monetary settlement to be made as a basis of conciliation. The HEI shall facilitate a conciliation process through ICC, as the Certified True Copy

case may be, once it is sought. The resolution of the conflict to the full satisfaction of the aggrieved party wherever possible, is preferred to purely punitive intervention.

- (8) The identities of the aggrieved party or victim or the witness or the offender shall not be made public or kept in the public domain especially during the process of the inquiry.
- 9. Interim redressal-The HEI may,
- (a) transfer the complainant or the respondent to another section or department to minimise the risks involved in contact or interaction, if such a recommendation is made by the ICC;
- (b) grant leave to the aggrieved with full protection of status and benefits for a period up to three months;
- restrain the respondent from reporting on or evaluating the work or performance or tests or examinations
 of the complainant;
- (d) ensure that offenders are warned to keep a distance from the aggrieved, and wherever necessary, if there
 is a definite threat, restrain their entry into the campus;
- (e) take strict measures to provide a conducive environment of safety and protection to the complainant against retaliation and victimisation as a consequence of making a complaint of sexual harassment.
- 10. Punishment and compensation- (1) Anyone found guilty of sexual harassment shall be punished in accordance with the service rules of the HEI, if the offender is an employee.
- (2) Where the respondent is a student, depending upon the severity of the offence, the HEI may,-
 - (a) withhold privileges of the student such as access to the library, auditoria, halls of residence, transportation, scholarships, allowances, and identity card;
 - (b) suspend or restrict entry into the campus for a specific period;
 - expel and strike off name from the rolls of the institution, including denial of readmission, if the offence so warrants;
 - (d) award reformative punishments like mandatory counselling and, or, performance of community services.
- (3) The aggrieved person is entitled to the payment of compensation. The HEI shall issue direction for payment of the compensation recommended by the ICC and accepted by the Executive Authority, which shall be recovered from the offender. The compensation payable shall be determined on the basis of-
 - (a) mental trauma, pain, suffering and distress caused to the aggrieved person;
 - (b) the loss of career opportunity due to the incident of sexual harassment;
 - (c) the medical expenses incurred by the victim for physical, psychiatric treatment;
 - (d) the income and status of the alleged perpetrator and victim; and
 - (e) the feasibility of such payment in lump sum or in instalments.
- 11. Action against frivolous complaint.—To ensure that the provisions for the protection of employees and students from sexual harassment do not get misused, provisions against false or malicious complaints have to be made and publicised within all HEIs. If the ICC concludes that the allegations made were false, malicious or the complaint was made knowing it to be untrue, or forged or misleading information has been provided during the inquiry, the complainant shall be liable to be punished as per the provisions of sub-regulations (1) of regulations 10, if the complainant happens to be an employee and as per sub-regulation (2).

of that regulation, if the complainant happens to be a student. However, the mere inability to substantiate a complaint or provide adequate proof will not attract attention against the complainant. Malicious intent on the part of the complainant shall not be established without an inquiry, in accordance with the procedure prescribed, conducted before any action is recommended.

- 12. Consequences of non-compliance.—(1) The Commission shall, in respect of any institution that will fully contravenes or repeatedly fails to comply with the obligations and duties laid out for the prevention, prohibition and redressal of sexual harassment of employees and students, take one or more of the following actions after providing due notice: -
- (a) withdrawal of declaration of fitness to receive grants under section 12B of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956.
- removing the name of the university or college from the list maintained by the Commission under clause (f) of section 2 of said Act, 1956;
- (c) withholding any grant allocated to the institution;
- (d) declaring the institution ineligible for consideration for any assistance under any of the general or special assistance programmes of the Commission;
- (e) informing the general public, including potential candidates for employment or admission, through a notice displayed prominently in the newspapers or other suitable media and posted on the website of the Commission, declaring that the institution does not provide for a zero tolerance policy against sexual harassment;
- (f) recommending the affiliating university for withdrawal of affiliation, in case of a college;
- recommending the Central Government for withdrawal of declaration as an institution deemed to be university, in case of an institution deemed to be university;
- recommending the appropriate State Government for withdrawal of status as university in case of a university established or incorporated under a State Act.
- (i) taking such other action within its powers as it may deem fit and impose such other penalties as may be provided in the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 for such duration of time till the institution complies with the provisions of these regulations.
- (2) No action shall be taken by the Commission under these regulations unless the Institution has been given an opportunity to explain its position and an opportunity of being heard has been provided to it.

. Vishaka Guidelines against

Sexual Harassment at Workplace

Guidelines and norms laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Vishaka and Others Vs. State of Rajasthan and Others(JT 1997 (7) SC 384)

HAVING REGARD to the definition of 'human rights' in Section 2 (d) of the Protection of Human Rights Act, 1993,

TAKING NOTE of the fact that the present civil and penal laws in India do not adequately provide for specific protection of women from sexual harassment in work places and that enactment of such legislation will take considerable time.

It is necessary and expedient for employers in work places as well as other responsible persons or institutions to observe certain guidelines to ensure the prevention of sexual harassment of women.

Duty of the Employer or other responsible persons in work places and other institutions

It shall be the duty of the employer or other responsible persons in work places or other institutions to prevent or deter the commission of acts of sexual harassment and to provide the procedures for the resolution, settlement or prosecution of acts, of sexual harassment by taking all steps required.

Definition

For this purpose, sexual harassment includes such unwelcome sexually determined behaviour (whether directly or by implication) as:

- a) Physical contact and advances;
- b) A demand or request for sexual favours;
- e) Sexually coloured remarks;
- d) Showing pornography;
- e) Any other unwelcome physical, verbal or non-verbal conduct of sexual nature





Where any of these acts is committed in circumstances where-under the victim of such conduct has a reasonable apprehension that in relation to the victim's employment or work whether she is drawing salary, or honorarium or voluntary, whether in government, public or private enterprise such conduct can be humiliating and may constitute a health and safety problem. It is discriminatory for instance when the woman has reasonable grounds to believe that her objection would disadvantage her in connection with her employment or work including recruiting or promotion or when it creates a hostile work environment. Adverse consequences might be visited if the victim does not consent to the conduct in question or raises any objection thereto.

Preventive Steps

All employers or persons in charge of work place whether in public or private sector should take appropriate steps to prevent sexual harassment. Without prejudice to the generality of this obligation they should take the following steps:

- A. Express prohibition of sexual harassment as defined above at the work place should be notified, published and circulated in appropriate ways.
- B. The Rules/Regulations of Government and Public Sector bodies relating to conduct and discipline should include rules/regulations prohibiting sexual harassment and provide for appropriate penalties in such rules against the offender.
- C. As regards private employers, steps should be taken to include the aforesaid prohibitions in the standing orders under the Industrial Employment (Standing Orders) Act, 1946.
- D. Appropriate work conditions should be provided in respect of work, leisure, health and hygiene to further ensure that there is no hostile environment towards women at work places and no employee woman should have reasonable grounds to believe that she is disadvantaged in connection with her employment.



Criminal Proceedings

Where such conduct amounts to a specific offence under the Indian Penal Code or under any other law, the employer shall initiate appropriate action in accordance with law by making a complaint with the appropriate authority.

In particular, it should ensure that victims or witnesses are not victimized or discriminated against while dealing with complaints of sexual harassment. The victims of sexual harassment should have the option to seek transfer of the perpetrator or their own transfer.

Disciplinary Action

Where such conduct amounts to misconduct in employment as defined by the relevant service rules, appropriate disciplinary action should be initiated by the employer in accordance with those rules.

Complaint Mechanism

Whether or not such conduct constitutes an offence under law or a breach of the service rules, an appropriate complaint mechanism should be created in the employer's organisation for redress of the complaint made by the victim. Such complaint mechanism should ensure time bound treatment of complaints.

Complaints Committee

The complaint mechanism, referred to above, should be adequate to provide, where necessary, a Complaints Committee, a special counsellor or other support service, including the maintenance of confidentiality.

The Complaints Committee should be headed by a woman and not less than half of its member should be women. Further, to prevent the possibility of any undue pressure or influence from senior levels, such Complaints Committee should involve a third party, either NGO or other body who is familiar with the issue of sexual barassment.

The Complaints Committee must make an annual report to the Government department concerned of the complaints and action taken by them.

Certified Tree Copy

The employers and person in charge will also report on the compliance with the aforesaid guidelines including on the reports of the Complaints Committee to the Government department.

Worker's Initiative

Employees should be allowed to raise issues of sexual harassment at a workers' meeting and in other appropriate forum and it should be affirmatively discussed in Employer-Employee Meetings.

Awareness

Awareness of the rights of female employees in this regard should be created in particular by prominently notifying the guidelines (and appropriate legislation when enacted on the subject) in a suitable manner.

Third Party Harassment

Where sexual harassment occurs as a result of an act or omission by any third party or outsider, the employer and person in charge will take all steps necessary and reasonable to assist the affected person in terms of support and preventive action.

The Central/State Governments are requested to consider adopting suitable measures including legislation to ensure that the guidelines laid down by this order are also observed by the employers in Private Sector.

These guidelines will not prejudice any rights available under the Protection of Human Rights Act, 1993.

GUIDELINES FOR GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL MECHANISM FOR THE STUDENTS

1. Introduction

Pursuant to UGC Regulations, 2012 on Grievance Redressal, as notified in the Gazette of India, dated March 23, 2013, the Jagan Nath University, Jaipur, hereby notifies Guidelines in broad conformity with the said Regulations of UGC, with an aim to address the grievances of students of Jagan Nath University, Jaipur.

These Guidelines shall completely supersede and replace the existing Guidelines of JNUJ on Students Grievance Redressal.

These Guidelines shall be in force with immediate effect.

2. Definitions

In these JNUJ Guidelines, unless the context otherwise requires:

- "aggrieved students" means a student who has any complaint in the matters concerned with the grievances defined under these regulations, and includes a person seeking admission to any Department of Jagan Nath University;
- (ii) "institution" means the institution created under JNUJ Act to conduct a course/program of study for obtaining any qualification from university and which, in accordance with the rules and regulations of university, is recognized as competent to provide for such course of study and present students undergoing such course of study for the examination for the award of such qualification;
- (iii) "declared admission policy" means the policy for admission to a course or program of study as offered by Jagan Nath University, Jaipur and its off campus at Lucknow and published in the prospectus.
- (iv) "Grievances" include the following complaints of the aggrieved students, namely:
 - Making admission contrary to merit determined in accordance with the declared admission policy of the institute;
 - b) Complaints of irregularity in the admission process adopted by the university, if any;
 - Refusal of admission in accordance with the declared admission policy of the institute;
 - d) Non publication of prospectus, as specified by UGC;
 - e) Any information, published in the prospectus, which is false or misleading, and not based on facts;
 - f) Withhold or refuse to return any document in the form of certificates of degree, diploma or any other award or other document deposited with it by a person for the purpose of seeking admission in such institution, with a view to induce or compel such person to pay any fee or fees in respect of any course or program of study which such person does not intend to pursue;
 - g) Demand of money in excess of that specified in the declared admission policy or approved by the competent authority to be charged by such institutions;
 - b) Breach of the policy for reservation in admission as may be applicable;
 - Complaints of alleged discrimination of students, from the underprivileged and marginalized section of society ,women or disabled categories;
 - Non-payment or delay in payment of scholarships to any student that is committed by the university




- belay in conduct of examinations or declaration of results beyond that specified in the academic calendar;
- On provision of student amenities as may have been promised or required to be provided by the institution;
- m) Denial of quality education as promised at the time of admission or required to be provided;
- n) Non transparent or unfair evaluation practices;
- o) Harassment and victimization of students;

3. GRIEVANCES REDRESSAL COMMITTEE

- The Vice Chancellor of Jagan Nath University, Jaipur herein shall constitute a StandingGrievanze Redressal Committee consisting of five members.
 - a senior Professor of the University Chairman;
 - a senior faculty drawn from the institutes, on rotation basis, to be nominated by the Vice Chancellor- Member;
 - iii. Head of Institute (HOI) where the grievance has occurred
 - iv. a student representative, drawn from the institute(s), on rotation basis where the grievance has occurred to be nominated, based on academic merit, by the concernedHead of Institute (HOI) – special invitee
 - v. Dean Students' Welfare (DSW)- Member Secretary
- The composition of Standing Grievances Redressal Committee shall not change; however, the members so nominated will have a term of two years.
- The Standing Grievances Redressal Committee shall communicate its decision within ten days of receipt of the complaint.
- d. Any person aggrieved by the decision of the Grievance Redressal Committee or not satisfied by its decision may within a period of six days prefer an appeal to the Appellate Authority, created for the purpose. The Chairman shall assume the responsibility as that of Ombudsman.
- e. Any student, not satisfied with the existing redressal mechanism in Jagan Nath University, may prefer another complain to this Committee, through DSW.
- f. The University hereby establishes a Registry, headed by DSW. A transparent mechanismof handling Registry shall be decided by DSW which may be reviewed by the Appellate Authority, if needed.

4. Appellate Authority/ Ombudsman

a. The Registry, headed by DSW will also act as Member Secretary to the Appellate Authority/ Ombudsman. The DSW shall place all such appeal out of cases, dealt under clause A to Appellate Authority. Any aggrieved student or person may prefer an appeal seeking Redressal of grievances, not being satisfied by the decision of Standing Grievances Redressal Committee and such appeal cases shall be placed before the Appellate Authority/Ombudsman by DSW. Some serious Grievance cases and the grievances/application addressed to Ombudsman may be taken up directly with the Ombudsman/Appellate Authority by DSW in consultation with the Chairman, Standing Grievance Redressal Committee.






5. Constitution of Appellate Authority/ Ombudsman

The Jagan Nath University, Jaipur herein constitutes Appellate Authority comprising offollowing members.

- i. Chairman / Ombudsman to be nominated by a separate office order.
- ii. Registrar
- iii. HOI concerned in respect of which the appeal/ grievance is linked.
- Co-opted Member (Director-Academics/ Director-Admission, COE and others as may be needed, depending on the case and nature of grievance)
- v. DSW- Member Secretary
- a. The details of the registry so established shall be published widely including on the notice board and prospectus and placed on the website of the University.

6. PROCEDURE IN REDRESSAL OF APPEAL/GRIEVANCES BY OMBUDSMAN/APPELLATE AUTHORITY AND GRIEVANCE BY STANDING GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL COMMITTEE:

- a. On receipt of an application by the registry, the official-in-charge shall inform the DSW, the Member Secretary to the Standing Grievances Redressal Committee and shall immediately provide a copy to the concerned HOI or Official concerned in the University for furnishing its reply within seven days.
- The Member Secretary shall arrange hearing by convening the meeting of Standing Grievance Redressal Committee and record the proceedings.
- c. The appeal cases shall be referred by DSW to the Appellate Authority through its Chairman and a hearing shall be conducted following a due process.
- d. The Ombudsman/Appellate Authority shall fix a date for hearing the complaint or complainant which shall be communicated to the aggrieved person either in writing or electronically, as may be feasible.
- e. An aggrieved person may appear either in person or represented by such person as maybe authorized to present his/her case.
- The Ombudsman/Appellate Authority shall be guided by the principles of natural justice while hearing the grievances.
- g. The Ombudsman/Appellate Authority shall ensure disposal of every application as speedily as possible; however, not later than a month of receipt of the grievance/appeal.
- The University shall co-operate with the Ombudsman/ Appellate Authority, in redressal of grievance and provide administrative support.
- i. On the conclusion of proceedings, the Ombudsman/Chairman, Appellate Authority or the Standing-Grievances Redressal Committee, as the case may be, shall pass such order, with reasons for such order, as may be deemed fit to redress the grievance and provide such relief as may be desirable to the affected party at issue.
- j. Every order under the signature of the Ombudsman/Chairman, Appellate Authority or the Chairman, Standing Grievances Redressal Committee, as the case may be, shall be provided to the aggrieved person and the Head of Institute and shall be placed on the website of the University.
- The University shall comply with the order of the Ombudsman/Chairman, Appellate Authority.






- Any order of the Ombudsman/Appellate Authority, not complied with by University, the complainant may prefer reporting to the Commission (UGC).
- m. A complaint shall be filed by the aggrieved student or his parent or with a special permission from the Ombudsman/Appellate Authority or the Standing Grievances Redressal Committee, as the case may be, by any other person.
- In case of any false or frivolous complaint, the Ombudsman may order appropriate action against the complainant.

7. MECHANISM FOR GRIEVANCE HANDLING

- a. Pursuant to these Guidelines of JNUJ, a proper Students Grievance Redressal Mechanismshall be in place to create a 'Registry' to be managed by Deputy DSW or the official nominated by DSW for the purpose, in the office of DSW. The DSW shall act as Member Secretary to Standing Grievance Redressal Committee.
- b. The student or the guardians may submit their query/complaint/grievance either to concerned Head of Institution/Department or the Dy.DSW, as per prescribed proforma given at Annexure A. If required, an application giving full details may also be enclosed.
- All the Heads of Institutions/Departments shall forward the complaints of students, received in the Institution, to the Registry, in the office of DSW.
- d. The person managing the Registry in the office of DSW shall enter it in a Register as per details given in Annexure B. The serial number of the entry made in the Register will be mentioned in the Acknowledgement as specified at Annexure A.
- The Dy/DSW shall seek the comments of concerned Head and forward the same, on being fully satisfied, to the complainant.
- f. The DSW, shall decide, depending on nature of complaints, to refer the complaints to the Standing Grievance Redressal Committee and convene a meeting accordingly.
- g. Where a written reply is required to be given to the students, based on the decision of Standing Grievance Redressal Committee, by the DSW, the a copy of it should be attached with theproforma Afor records.
- h. If the grievance of the applicant is not redressed within the expected time or in the expected manner, the applicant may report the matter to higher authority, i.e. Appellate Authority/ Ombudsman. If the matter relates to more than one Institution/Department, the office of DSW shall coordinate with all such Institutions/ Departments and ensure that theissue is resolved.

- · To act as a forum for information sharing and exchange of ideas.

- Any complaints of Sexual harassment received by WDC would be directed to the ICC and full assistance would be provided to find justice in the case.


7. REVIEW OF POLICY







What Constitutes Ragging?

Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts:

- (a) any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student;
- (b) indulging in rowdy or indisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student;
- (c) asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student;
- (d) any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher;
- (e) exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students;
- (f) any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students;
- (g) any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing absence and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person;







GUIDELINES FOR THE PROCTORIAL BOARD

The students of Jagan Nath University are expected to behave with responsibility at all
times and show a caring attitude, accepting diversity and respect for the feelings of other
students. A student is expected to behave in a manner which reflects cooperation, good
judgment, and appropriate standards. The University reserves the right to take any action
that it deems necessary or appropriate to protect the intellectual integrity, safety, and well
being of the campus community.

Students are responsible for their conduct to the Dean/HoD and are prohibited from doing anything either inside or outside the University that will amount to a breach of discipline or interference in the disciplinary and normal working of the University. A student shall be liable to disciplinary action for violation of any of the rules of discipline. Disciplinary action may involve warning and/or suspension from classes, from the examination, from use of the University library or even from the University as such, or any such action as provided for in the guidelines.

2. Prohibited Students Conduct:


- (i) Students should not make noise within the university premises. Students are forbidden to sing, whistle, hoot, shout or indulge in any objectionable behavior or activity in university premises at anytime or during travelling in University bus.
- (ii) Punctuality in class timings and proper discipline in class rooms should be strictly observed. Students must behave properly both inside the class room and in the university premises and he/she must refrain from doing anything that will cause disturbance to the ongoing classes or their fellow students.
- (iii) Loitering in the corridors or sitting on steps or corners is strictly prohibited. No student is allowed to wander and move aimlessly in or around the university.
- (iv) Every part of the university building shall be kept clean. No wall fixtures, models, specimens or charts, notices should be pierced, defaced, mutilated, or damaged in any way.
- (v) Damage in any form caused by a student due to his / her negligence or deliberate intention shall be repaired at the expense of the student(s) responsible for the negligence.
- (vi) No student should address any conference including press conference, nor write to the press on a political subject or matter concerning the administration of the university. No posters or banners can be displayed without the approval of the concerned Coordinator.



- (vii) Stealing or attempting to steal, university property or another person's personal property is considered a serious offence and any such incident will be taken up seriously.
- (viii) Harassment in any form, is considered a serious offence as the respect, dignity and self esteem of another individual are affected. Any reported case of harassment will result in severe disciplinary action. Harassment includes sexual harassment, which is defined as repeated and unwanted verbal or physical sexual advances, derogatory statements or remarks which cause the recipient discomfort or humiliation.
 - (ix) During the classes if any student is found in canteen area, playgrounds and any Labs then strict action will be taken against him/her.
 - (x) Using, possessing, distributing, purchasing, or selling tobacco materials, alcoholic beverages are strictly prohibited. Students sound under the influence of any of the above was not permitted to attend university or university functions. Use of liquor, drugs any other forms of addiction or smoking is strictly prohibited in the university premises.
- (xi) Using, possessing, controlling, or transferring of a weapon shall be severely dealt with.
- (xii) Use of cellular phone, digital camera or other electronic devices in any manner that disrupts the educational environment or violates the rights of others should be strictly avoided. All electronic devices must be kept out of sight during the regular university days, unless: (i) the supervising teacher grants permission; (ii) use of the device is provided in a student's IEP; or (iii) it is needed in an emergency that threatens the safety of students, staff, or other individuals.
- (xiii) Engaging in academic dishonesty, including but not limited to cheating, intentionally Plagiarizing, wrongfully giving or receiving help during an academic examination, and wrongfully obtaining test copies or scores will not be tolerated by the authorities.
- (xiv) Using any form or type of aggressive behavior that does physical or mental harm to someone else and/or urging other students to engage in such conduct is banned. (Prohibited Aggressive behavior includes, without limitation, the use of violence, force, noise, coercion, threats, intimidation, fear, bullying, cyber bullying, hazing, or other comparable conduct;
 - Cyber bullying is the use of e-mail, instant/text messaging, chat room s, pagers, cell phones, or other forms of information technology to deliberately harass, threaten, or intimidate someone. Cyber bullying can include such acts as making threats, sending provocative insults or cultural or ethnic slurs, gay bashing, religious, attempting to infect the victim's computer with a virus, and flooding an e-mail inbox with nonsense messages;

Bullying may be defined as intimidation with a harsh look and or physical and verbal threats. This is also against the rules.)

- (xv) Violation of any criminal law, such as assault, battery, arson, theft, gambling, and hazing will result in striking off names of the defaulters from university rolls.
 - (xvi) Students shall leave their bicycles, scooters or motorcycles in the shed provided for this purpose. No bicycles, scooters or motorcycles shall be parked in any other part of the University premises.
 - (xvii) Students shall conduct themselves in a polite manner, both towards the members of the staff (teaching and administrative) and towards their fellow students.

Insubordination, unbecoming language or unacceptable conduct including teasing etc., shall be severely dealt with.

3. Composition of the Proctorial Board

- (1) The Board shall be constituted by the Vice-Chancellor as follows:
 - (i) Chief Proctor (Chairperson)
 - (ii) Deputy Chief Proctor(s)
 - (iii) Not more than eight members representing various departments.

Provided that the chairperson of the Board may associate any other teaching or administrative staff, as he deems fit, with the proceedings of the Board.

- (2) The quorum for meetings or hearings of the Board shall be 3 (provided that the Chief Proctor or Dy. Chief Proctor is present, plus at least two other members).
- (3) Before taking disciplinary action, the student shall be given an opportunity of hearing.
- (4) The Board shall include in agenda any complaints of indiscipline, written, oral or Suo-moto, on the sole behest of the Chief Proctor.
- (5) In event of a dead lock in case of voting on a decision, the Chief Proctor shall have a casting vote.


4. Role of the Proctorial Board

- The Board has a general role to promote the welfare of the members of the University community.
- (ii) The Board has a formal role to receive and act upon complaints of alleged breaches of these guidelines which are referred to it, whether by a Student, a member of staff or any other person or body.
- (iii) The Board, in exercising its formal role under paragraph (ii) above, shall primarily hear less serious complaints of alleged breaches of these guidelines and will encourage informal resolution and mediation wherever appropriate.

Action against indisciplinary conduct:

Disciplinary action may be taken against any student guilty of gross disobedience or misconduct. Students who are under the influence of any prohibited substance will not be permitted to attend university or university functions and will be treated as though they had the prohibited substance, as applicable, in their possession. Any complaint will be investigated by the Proctorial Board of the university and the recommendations will be forwarded to the VC office for taking necessary action.

 Expulsion: Permanent severance of the student's relationship with the University. Any student found guilty of persistent violation of guidelines shall be rusticated or dismissed from the University by the Proctorial Board.





- Disciplinary Suspension: Temporary severance of the student's relationship with the University for a Specific Period of time. It may involve suspension from classes, hostels, examination, university etc.
- 3. Disciplinary Probation: Notice to the student that any further major disciplinary violation may result in suspension; disciplinary probation might also include one or more of the following: the setting of restriction, the issuing of a reprimand, restitution.

4. Reprimand and Warning:

- (a) Oral Reprimand and Warning an oral reprimand issued to the student, possibly including warnings of further disciplinary action in the event of any future violation of the guidelines.
- (b) Letter of Reprimand and Warning- a written statement of disapproval to the student, possibly including warnings of further disciplinary action in the event of any future violation of the guidelines.
- Restitution: reimbursement for damage to or misappropriation of property; this may take the form of appropriate service or other compensation.

Appeal

The decision reached at the hearing will be communicated to the student; it will specify the action taken by the Board.

The student shall be notified of his/her right to appeal the decision of the hearing body to the Pro-Vice Chancellor, Vice Chancellor of the University. A copy of the final decision shall be transmitted to the student.


7. Corporal punishment is prohibited

Corporal punishment is defined as slapping, paddling, and intentional infliction of bodily harm or pain. However, members of the university staff may use reasonable force when necessary to maintain safety, protect the student and other individuals from bodily harm, or avoid damage to university property.

 Parents and guardians are expected to co-operate with the authorities of the University by prevailing upon and motivating their wards not to take part in any antisocial activities.
