	These amounts have been received through formal process and duly accounted for in the books of accounts. On receipt of the funds, the University used to acknowledge the receipts by way of issuing an acknowledgement letter. Since the money received was in small amounts, no formal MoU etc. was signed. The audited statements of the total funds received under this category are attached.			
	The University is young and the process of getting donations/ grants from non-government organizations/ individuals is expected to further pick up in future. Keeping in view the regular in flow of funds under this category, the University claims optimal score on this metric.
