Report on International Women's Day

Around the world and through the decades, many people shared in the global struggle for gender equality. Regardless of our age, country, background or gender, the fight for equal rights has collectively defined our lives and we must take action together to achieve it. This International Women's Day, UN Women's multi-generational campaign, Generation Equality, brings together past and present advocates to demand gender equality in this generation.

International Women's Day (IWD) is celebrated on the 8th of March every year. It is a focal point in the movement for women's rights.

International Women's Day is a time to reflect on progress made, to call for change and to celebrate acts of courage and determination by ordinary women, who have played an extraordinary role in the history of their countries and communities. The world has made unprecedented advances, but no country has achieved gender equality.

Fifty years ago, we landed on the moon; in the last decade, we discovered new human ancestors and photographed a black hole for the first time.

In the meantime, legal restrictions have kept 2.7 billion women from accessing the same choice of jobs as men. Less than 25 per cent of parliamentarians were women, as of 2019. One in three women experience gender-based violence, still. The theme of International Women's Day 2020 is, Generation Equality: Realizing Women's Rights. So, for the celebration of the International Women's Day 2020, Student Welfare Cell and Women Development Cell, Jagannath University jointly organized various activities for students, faculties and other female staff members in the campus during the week from 1st to 7th March, 2020.

A **debate competition** has been organized for students on the theme "**Women Empowerment, Health and Education**" on 5th March, 2020 at Seminar Hall (1.00P.M-to 2.30 P.M) 12students participated in this competition. At the end of the event winner and runners awarded by mementoes. All participants got certificate for the participation.
