## **Student Induction Program**

### **1. Introduction**

The management and staff of the university regard Induction Program as one of the key element supporting our vision and mission of providing an environment of quality education, inculcating human values with a holistic concern for better life, environment and society, nurturing high quality talent and promoting dissemination of knowledge.

Induction is necessary for new students so that they are able to understand the routines and expectations of the university and are able to rapidly settle down to learning. We believe that induction plays a crucial role in influencing student's discernment of what we offer and our pledge to deliver high quality provision. We firmly believe that induction often forms our students' first experience about the university.

This Policy identifies the mechanism of induction for all new students (at UG and PG level). It is consistent with the commitments made in our vision and mission statement. The given policy is also in sync with our vow to enhance the quality of student's experience and to entrench all students into their respective departments, connecting them with fellow students, mentors and faculty members.

This Policy is dedicated to ensure constant quality improvement and will seek to evaluate, receive feedback and examine effectiveness of its implementation and will polish up policy and its implementation as and when required.

### **2. The main objectives of Induction Program:**

The main objective of Induction Program (Deekshaarambh) is to welcome and introduce all the new students joining our University, with the aim to commemorate and value their choice to come and join our diverse and vivacious learning community. We try to ensure that all our new students gets comfortable in the new surroundings as soon as possible. The larger goal is to acquaint them about the support and services available to them and enter into a collaborative effort of shaping their learnings and to gain the most out of life at the university.

The objectives of Students Induction Program cover a number of different aspects (SAGE):

**Socializing:** meeting other new students, senior students, students union, Lectures by Eminent People;

- Introduce students to key staff members and make formal introductions.
- Enable students to develop friendship groups and support networks at an early stage.
- Discussion about the aims of the course
- Provide Academic Calendar/Academic Framework/programme timetable, Course structure - core, options

- Provide a basic health and safety briefing and ensure students are aware of what to do in an emergency
- Organize special lecture series by eminent speakers from academia and corporate, to help them build a better understanding and adjustment to academic life.
- Receive feedback form students about the student recruitment and admissions process to promote continuous enhancement

**Associating:** visits to University / college, visits to Dept./Branch/ Programme of study & important places on campus, local area, city and so on;

- Familiarize them with the School's campus layout, facilities, support services and its Virtual Learning Environment
- Organizing day-out to acquaint with the local area, culture and surroundings.
- Provide students with the information and resources they need to begin their studies (such as handbooks and timetables).
- Make students aware of social and extracurricular events available to them

**Governing:** rules and regulations, student support etc;

- Ensure students are aware of key policies and procedures and understand what is expected from them to successfully complete their studies.
- Explain the assessment process in details.
- Enable students to understand support networks at an early stage

**Experiencing:** Subject lectures, study skills, small-group activities, physical activity, creative and performing arts, literary activities, universal human values, etc.

- Conducting ice-breakers exercises/games, team activities and bonding activities
- Conducting debates, elocutions, book reviewing sessions for developing an insight into the given topics.

### 3. Role of Various Functionaries :

- The management will ascertain that all new students are personally welcomed by the Vice-Chancellor, the Registrar, and Heads of the Deaprtments or other members of the Corporate Management Team.
- Dean/Heads of Department have overall responsibility for ensuring adequate planning, allocation of resources and implementation of induction programmes within their Departments.
- Each Department will be responsible for assessing the quality and effectiveness of delivering induction at the departmental level and its personal support/tutorial arrangements.

- Mentors will play a lead role in providing regular academic reviews which identify and monitor student progress, barriers to effective learning and provide academic and personal support.
- The modal officer has responsibility for ensuring the conduction of an effective induction programme for all students, for teaching good practice and making arrangements for appropriate Student Services to be available to contribute to the success of the induction programmes.
- All university staff will be expected to treat new students as well as continuing students with courtesy and professionalism.

**Departments are responsible for:**

- Planning , supporting and organising various events in induction program.
- The respective departments will play a key role in welcoming and introducing students to the range of extra-curricular and support services available at the departmental level.
- Where appropriate, checking students' ability to meet the demands of the course, particularly in respect of English Language proficiency and numeracy.

**The admission cell is responsible for:**

- enrolling students
- confirming student identities
- issuing ID cards
- collecting the first instalment of fees
- collecting information on nationality, ethnic origin, disability and special needs, term-time accommodation, educational background, documents etc.

The Counselling and Advisory Service is responsible for the institution-wide welcome of the students and their accompanying Parents

The Student Finance Unit is responsible for giving advice on matters concerned with student financial support.

Information Technology Services are responsible for the allocation of network log-in details.

**4. Learning Outcome:**

At the end of the program, participants were able to:

- Acquaint with the new environment.
- Understand and imbibe the ethos and culture of the institution.
- Develop a bond with other students and faculty members.
- Create a better understanding about the institutional policies, processes, practices, culture and values.

**5. Mode and Duration:**

### About Session-II

#### Topic: “Imbibing thoughts for better future”

Resource Person: Prof. R.K.Behl, Dean, Ag, Jagannath University, Bhadurgarh

The purpose of the session is to develop values and positive thoughts amongst the students, Prof. Behl stressed that Values are the positive teachings provided to help us and tread the right path in life. Every parent and teacher wants his/her child/student to imbibe these. These can even be referred to as good qualities. A person who imbibes good values grows on to become a responsible individual and he is capable of demarcating right and wrong. Also, he is able to make wiser decisions in life. He said that these five thoughts should be imbibed in the personality

1. **Acceptance – Acceptance of situations,** (The situation may not be exactly like the blue print of one's desire) -the more one resists, it still persists, and the more we accept, our ability to transform situation builds-that also helps us shift our focus from problems to solutions: **Energy Flows where attention goes.**
2. **Get in touch with yourself:** Sometimes we realize our strengths and weaknesses only during our darkest moments. Turn inwards, check your thoughts, feelings, dreams, visions, goals and align them. What you can do about it right now- **Building immunity-** Exercise, cleaning, eating habits, meditation, changing any habits if needed, Learn a new skill, take hands on your hobby.
3. **Design an outcome for your life:** One needs to be passionate about creating a life [future] that they want, to explore the new found reality and it's important to always hold on to that vision of where you want your life to go on from here. **Redesign your life goals/outcome of your life.**
4. **Become aware of your Resources:** In trying times, it becomes even more important to remind yourself of all your internal and external resources and blessings that you have with you right now and be grateful. In Every Adversity there is a seed for opportunity. There is always something good in everything that happens to us – check the positive intention.
5. **Law of Impermanence:** Know nothing is permanent, everything changes, change is the only constant thing. This too shall pass. **Rough-Seas makes great sailors.**

About the Trainer: Prof..Suneel Keswani is a versatile Scholar and a Trainer. He holds a Masters Degree in Commerce (M. Com) from Delhi University, MA (Education) from IGNOU

& presently Research Scholar in Education. Mr. Keswani has a hardcore corporate experience of total 33 years, having worked in the marketing divisions of large Corporate Houses like – CMC Ltd, Shriram Group and The Times of India. He recently co -founded Leadership Avenue, an Online Life Skills Series under the theme Reset Zindagi. For the last 27 years he is actively involved in conducting Training and Development programs / Workshops in major Management & Communication areas and Life Skills in lead Companies and is a visiting faculty to a number of premier B -Schools, Universities and Professional Institutes like ICAI & ICSI across pan India.

**Details of the session:** Prof. Keswani said to the students that in their quest to become a lifelong learner, they should not neglect reading. Reading is one of the best and most flexible and accessible tools of lifelong learning. Reading is a key to expanding the knowledge. Maintain a list of books, articles, and papers that the students want to read for self-development or to update their technical knowledge. Update this list frequently, and add new material as they discover them. Apply rapid reading skills to scan the material quickly to determine its value and to find the material they want
