This is in continuation to the Commission Order of even number dated 20th March, 2024 wherein the recommendations of the Expert Review Committee were communicated to Jagannath University, Rajasthan.

2. As per the provisions under Regulation 6 of the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020, the Higher Educational Institution was provided an opportunity to submit an appeal along with requisite fee and documentary evidence for the programme(s) not recognized as per the UGC letter cited in above para, if any, within 30 days from the date of the communication of assessment sheet of the Expert Review Committee (as communicated in the said UGC letter).



- 3. The appeal along with documents submitted by the Jagannath University, Rajasthan have been placed before duly constituted Standing Appellate Committee in the virtual meeting held on 17.10.2023. The Standing Appellate Committee based on the appeal submitted along with documentary evidences, interaction with HEIs representatives and the provisions of the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 and its amendments; made recommendations for consideration of the Competent Authority/Commission.
