NOTIFICATION

Jaipur, April 21, 2008

No. F.2(22)Vidhi/2/2008.- In pursuance of clause (3) of article 348 of the constitution of India, the Governor is pleased to authorize the publication in the Rajasthan Gazette of the following translation in the English language of the Jagan Nath Vishwavidhyalaya, Jaipur Adhiniyam, 2008 (2008 Ka Adhiniyam Sankhyank 19):

(Authorised English Translation)

THE JAGAN NATH UNIVERSITY, JAIPUR

ACT, 2008

(Act No. 19 of 2008) (Received the assent of the Governor on the 16th day of April, 2008)

> An Act

to provide for establishment and incorporation of the Jagan Nath University, Jaipur in the State of Rajasthan and matters connected therewith and incidental thereto.

Whereas, with a view to keep pace with the rapid development in all spheres of knowledge in the world and the country, it is essential to create world level modern research and study facilities in the State to provide state of the art educational facilities to the youth at their door steps so that they can make out of them human resources compatible to liberalized economic and social order of the world;

And whereas, rapid advancement in knowledge and changing requirements of human resources makes it essential that a resourceful and quick and responsive system of educational research and development be created which can work with entrepreneurial zeal under an essential regulatory setup and such a system can be created by allowing the private institutions engaged in higher education having sufficient resources and experience to establish universities and by incorporating such universities with such regulatory provisions as ensure efficient working of such institutions;

And whereas, the Jagan Nath Gupta Memorial Education Society, a Society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 having its registered office at 3, Industrial Area, Sector-5, Rohini, Delhi-110085, is engaged in the field of education for last 15 years and is running several educational institutions, which are imparting education in the disciplines like Management, Engineering & Technology and Communication & Design etc.;

And whereas, said Jagan Nath Gupta Memorial Education Society has set up educational infrastructures, both physical and academic, as specified in Schedule I, at Village Rampura Bujurga, Tehsil Chaksu, District Jaipur in the State of Rajasthan and is keen to establish and run a University for research and studies in the disciplines specified in Schedule II and in token thereof has deposited an amount of rupees one crore to be utilized in establishment of an endowment fund in accordance with the provisions of this Act;

And whereas, the sufficiency of the above infrastructure has been got enquired into by a committee, appointed in this behalf by the State Government consisting of the Vice-chancellor, University of Bikaner, Bikaner, Officer on Special Duty, Higher Education, Government of Rajasthan, Jaipur, Dr. Pradeep Sharma, Prof. Department of Psychiatric, S.M.S. Medical College, Jaipur and Principal, Engineering College, Jhalawar;

And whereas, if the aforesaid infrastructure is utilized in incorporation as a University and the said Jagan Nath Gupta Memorial Education Society is allowed to run the University, it would contribute in the academic development of the people of the State;

Now, therefore, be it enacted by the Rajasthan State Legislature in the Fifty- Ninth Year of the Republic of India, as follows:-

1. Short title, extent and commencement.-

- (1) This Act may be called the Jagan Nath University, Jaipur Act, 2008.
- (2) It extends to the whole of the State of Rajasthan.
- (3) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. Definitions: In this act, unless the context otherwise requires.
 - (a) "Private University Law" means a Private University Act specified in the Schedule; and
 - (b) "Schedule" means the Schedule to this Act.
 - (c) "AICTE" means All India Council of Technical Education established under All India Council of Technical Education Act, 1987 (Central Act No. 52 of 1987);

- (d) "CSIR" means the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research, New Delhi a funding agency of the Central Government;
- (e) "DEC" means the Distance Education Council established under section 28 of Indira Gandhi National Open University Act, 1985 (Central Act No. 50 of 1985);
- (f) "Distance education" means education imparted by combination of any two or more means of communication, viz. broadcasting, telecasting, correspondence courses, seminars, contact programmes and any other such methodology;
- (g) "DST" means the Department of Science and Technology of the Central Government;
- (h) "employee" means a person appointed by the University to work in the University and includes teachers, officers and other employees of the University;
- "fee" means collection made by the University from the students by whatever name it may be called, which is not refundable;
- (j) "Government" means the State Government of Rajasthan;
- (k) "higher education" means study of a curriculum or course for the pursuit of knowledge beyond 10+2 level;
- "hostel" means a place of residence for the students of the University, or its colleges, institutions or centers, maintained or recognized to be as such by the University;
- (m) "ICAR" means the Indian Council of Agriculture Research, a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (Central Act No. 21 of 1860);
- (n) "MCI" means Medical Council of India constituted under section 3 of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (Central Act No. 102 of 1956);
- (o) "NAAC" means the National Assessment and Accreditation Council, Bangalore, an autonomous institution of the UGC;
- (p) "NCTE" means the National Council of Teacher Education constituted under section 3 of the National Council of Teacher Education Act, 1993 (Central Act No. 73 of 1993);

- (2) The movable and immovable property specified in the Schedule I shall be vested in the University and the Sponsoring Body shall, immediately after commencement of this Act, take steps for such vesting.
- (3) The University shall have perpetual succession and a common seal and shall sue and be sued by the said name.
- (4) The University shall situate and have its headquarters at village Rampura Bujurga, Tehsil Chaksu, District Jaipur.
- 4. The objects of the University.- The objects of the University shall be to undertake research and studies in the disciplines specified in Schedule II and such other disciplines as the University may with the prior approval of the State Government, determine from time to time and to achieve excellence and impart and disseminate knowledge in the said disciplines.
- 5. Powers and functions of the University. The University shall have the following powers and functions, namely:-
 - to provide for instruction in the disciplines specified in Schedule II and to make provisions for research and for the advancement and dissemination of knowledge;

- (w) to establish examination centers;
- (x) to ensure that the standard of degrees, diplomas, certificates and other academic distinctions are not lower than those laid down by AICTE, NCTE, UGC, MCI, PCI and other similar bodies established by or under any law for the time being in force for the regulation of education;
- (y) to set up off campus centre within []³ the State, subject to the provisions of any other law for the time being in force; and
- (z) to do all such other acts and things as may be necessary, incidental or conducive to the attainment of all or any of the objects of the University.
- University to be self-financed. The University shall be self-financed and shall not be entitled to receive any grant or other financial assistance from the State Government.
- 7. No power of affiliation.— The University shall have no power to affiliate or otherwise admit to its privileges any other institution.

8. Endowment Fund.-

- (1) There shall be established an Endowment Fund, as soon as may be after coming into force of this Act with an amount of rupees one crore which has been deposited by the Sponsoring Body with the State Government.
- (2) The Endowment Fund shall be used as security deposit to ensure that the University complies with the provisions of this Act and functions as per provisions of this Act, Statutes and Ordinances. The State Government shall have the powers to forfeit in the prescribed manner, a part or whole of the Endowment Fund in case the University or the Sponsoring body contravenes any of the provisions of this Act or Statutes, Ordinances, Regulations or rules made thereunder.
- (3) Income from the Endowment Fund may be utilised for development of infrastructure of the University but shall not be utilised to meet out the recurring expenditure of the University.
- (4) The amount of the Endowment Fund shall be invested and kept invested until the dissolution of the University in long term securities issued or guaranteed by the State Government or

13. *[The [President]17.-

- (1) The [President]¹⁸ shall be appointed by the [Chairperson]¹⁹ from a panel of not less than three and not more than five persons recommended by the Board of Management.
- (2) No person shall be eligible to appoint as President unless he is a distinguished academician having a minimum of ten years experience as Professor in a university or college or ten years of experience in an equivalent position in a reputed research and/or academic administrative organization.
- (3) The term of the office of the President shall be three years from the date on which he enters upon his office or until he attains the age of seventy years, whichever is earlier:

Provided that the same person shall be eligible for reappointment:

Provided further that a President shall, notwithstanding the expiration of his term, continue to hold office until his successor enters upon the office.

- (4) For the purpose of selection of the President, the Board of Management shall invite applications from eligible persons through a public notice and while considering the names of persons to be appointed as President, the Board of Management shall give proper weightage to academic excellence, exposure to the higher education system in the country and adequate experience in academic and administrative governance and record its findings in writing and enclose the same with the panel to be submitted to the Chairperson.
- (5) Any vacancy in the office of President shall be filled within six months from the date of such vacancy.
- (6) The President shall be the principal executive and academic officer of the University and shall exercise general superintendence and control over the affairs of the University and shall execute the decisions of the authorities of the University.
- (7) The President shall preside at the convocation of the University in the absence of the Chairperson.
- (8) If in the opinion of the President, it is necessary to take immediate action on any matter for which powers are conferred on any other

- (2) The Proctor shall be responsible for the maintenance of discipline among the students and keep the various students' unions advised of the various policies and practices in the University.
- (3) The Proctor shall exercise such other powers and perform such other duties as may be prescribed by the Statutes.

17. The Dean of Faculty.-

- (1) There shall be a Dean of each Faculty who shall be appointed by the [President]³⁷ for a period of three years in such manner as may be prescribed by the Statutes.
- (2) The Dean shall convene meetings of the faculty, as and when required, in consultation with the [President]³⁸ and shall preside over the same. He shall formulate the policies and development programme of the faculty and present the same to the appropriate authorities for their consideration.
- (3) The Dean of Faculty shall exercise such other powers and perform such other duties as may be prescribed by the Statutes.

18. The Registrar.-

- (1) The Registrar shall be appointed by the [Chairperson]³⁹, in such manner as may be prescribed by the Statutes.
- (2) All contracts shall be signed and all documents and records shall be authenticated by the Registrar on behalf of the University
- (3) The Registrar shall be the Member Secretary of the Board of Management and Academic Council but he shall not have a right to vote.

19. The Chief Finance and Accounts Officer .-


20. Other Officers.-

- The University may appoint such other officers as may be necessary for its functioning.
- (2) The manner of appointment and powers and functions of such officers shall be such as may be prescribed by the Statutes.
- 21. Authorities of the University.- The following shall be the authorities of the University, namely:
 - (1) the Board of Management;
 - (2) the Academic Council;
 - (3) the Faculties; and
 - (4) such other authorities as may be declared by the Statutes to be the authorities of the University.

22. The Board of Management.-

- the Board of Management of the University shall consist of the following namely:
 - (a) the [Chairperson]⁴¹;
 - (b) the [President]⁴²;
 - (c) five persons nominated by the Sponsoring Body out of whom two shall be eminent educationists;
 - (d) one expert of management or information technology from outside the University, nominated by the [Chairperson]⁴³;
 - (e) one expert of finance, nominated by the [Chairperson]⁴⁴;
 - (f) commissioner, College Education or his nominee not below the rank of Deputy Secretary, and
 - (g) two teachers, nominated by the [President]⁴⁵.
- (2) The Board of Management shall be the principal executive body of the University. All the movable and immovable property of the University shall vest in the Board of Management. It shall have

- (a) to provide general superintendence and directions and to control the functioning of the University by using all such powers as are provided by this Act or the Statutes, Ordinances, Regulations or rules made thereunder.
- (b) to review the decisions of other authorities of the University in case they are not in conformity with the provisions of this Act or the Statutes, Ordinances, Regulations or rules made thereunder;
- (c) to approve the budget and annual report of the University;
- (d) to lay down the policies to be followed by the University;
- (e) to recommend to the Sponsoring Body about the voluntary liquidation of the University if a situation arises when smooth functioning of the University does not remain possible, in spite of all efforts; and
- (f) such other powers as may be prescribed by the Statutes.
- (3) The Board of Management shall meet at least three times in a calendar year.
- (4) The quorum for meetings of the Board of Management shall be five.

23. The Academic Council.-

- The Academic Council shall consist of the [President]⁴⁶ and such other members as may be prescribed by the Statutes.
- (2) The [President]⁴⁷ shall be the Chairperson of the Academic Council.
- (3) The Academic Council shall be the principal academic body of the University and shall, subject to the provisions of this Act and the rules, Regulations, Statutes or Ordinances, made thereunder, coordinate and exercise general supervision over the academic policies of the University.
- (4) The quorum for meetings of the Academic Council shall be such as may be prescribed by the Statutes.
- 24. Other authorities.- The composition, constitution, powers and functions of other authorities of the University shall be such as may be prescribed by the Statutes.

- 25. Disqualification for membership of an authority.- A person shall be disqualified for being a member of any of the authorities of the University, if he-
 - (a) is of unsound mind and stands so declared by a competent court;
 - (b) is an undischarged insolvent;
 - (c) has been convicted of any offence involving moral turpitude;
 - (d) is conducting or engaging himself in private coaching classes; or
 - (e) has been punished for indulging in or promoting unfair practice in the conduct of any examination, in any form, anywhere.
- 26. Vacancies not to invalidate the proceedings of any authority of the University. No act or proceeding of any authority of the University shall be invalid merely by reason of any vacancy or defect in the constitution thereof.
- 27. Filling up of emergent vacancies. Any vacancies occurred in the membership of authorities of the University due to death, resignation or removal of a member or due to change of capacity in which he was appointed or nominated, shall be filled up as early as possible by the person or the body who had appointed or nominated such a member:

Provided that the person appointed or nominated as a member of an authority of the University on an emergent vacancy, shall remain member of such authority for only the remaining period of the member, in whose place he is appointed or nominated.

28. Committee .-

(1) The authorities or officers of the University may constitute such committees with such terms of reference as may be necessary for specific tasks to be performed by such committees. The constitution of such committees and their duties shall be such as may be prescribed by the Statutes.

29. The Statutes.-

- (1) Subject to the provisions of this Act, the Statutes of the University may provide for all or any of the following matters, namely:-
- the constitution, powers and functions of the authorities of the University as may be constituted from time to time;
- (b) the terms and conditions of appointment of the [President]⁴⁸ and his powers and functions;
- (c) the manner and terms and conditions of appointment of the

- Registrar and Chief Finance and Accounts Officer and their powers and functions:
- (d) the manner in which and the period for which the Provost and the Proctor shall be appointed and their powers and functions;
- the manner in which the Dean of Faculty shall be appointed and his powers and functions;
- the manner and terms and conditions of appointment of other officers and teachers and their powers and functions;
- (g) the terms and conditions of service of employees of the University and their functions;
- (h) the procedure for arbitration in case of disputes between officers, teachers, employees and students;
- (i) the conferment of honorary degrees;
- the provisions regarding exemption of students from payment of tuition fee and for awarding to them scholarships and fellowships;
- (k) provisions regarding the policy of admissions, including regulation of reservation of seats;
- provisions regarding fees to be charged from students;
- (m) provisions regarding number of seats in different courses;
- (n) creation of new authorities of the University;
- (o) accounting policy and financial procedure;
- (p) creation of new departments and abolition or restructuring of existing departments;
- (q) institution of medals and prizes;
- (r) creation of posts and procedure for abolition of posts;
- (s) revision of fees;
- (t) alteration of the number of seats in different syllabi; and
- (u) all other matters which under the provisions of this Act are required to be, or may be prescribed by the Statutes.
- (2) The Statutes of the University shall be made by the Board of Management and shall be submitted to the State Government for its approval.

- (3) The State Government shall consider the Statutes, submitted by the University and shall give its approval thereon within two months from the date of its receipt with such modifications, if any, as it may deem necessary.
- (4) The University shall communicate its agreement to the Statutes as approved by the State Government, and if it desires not to give effect to any or all of the modifications made by the State Government under sub- section (3), it may give reasons therefore and after considering such reason, the State Government may or may not accept the suggestions made by the University.
- (5) The State Government shall publish the Statutes, as finally approved by it, in the Official Gazette, and thereafter, the Statutes shall come into force from the date of such publication.

30. The Ordinances.-

- (1) Subject to the provisions of this Act or Statutes made there under, the Ordinances may provide for all or any of the following matters, namely:
 - the admission of students to the University and their enrolment as such;
 - (b) the courses of study to be laid down for the degrees, diplomas and certificates of the University;
 - (c) the award of the degrees, diplomas, certificates and other academic distinctions, the minimum qualifications for the same and the measures to be taken relating to the granting and obtaining of the same;
 - (d) the conditions for award of fellowships, scholarships, stipends, medals and prizes;
 - (e) the conduct of examinations, including the terms of office and manner of appointment and the duties of examining bodies, examiners and moderators;
 - (f) fees to be charged for the courses, examinations, degrees and diplomas of the University;
 - (g) the conditions of residence of the students of the University;
 - (h) provision regarding disciplinary action against the students;
 - (i) the creation, composition and functions of any other body which

is considered necessary for improving the academic life of the University;

- (j) the manner of co-operation and collaboration with other Universities and institutions of higher education; and
- (k) all other matters which by this Act or Statutes made thereunder are required to be provided by the Ordinances.
- (2) The Ordinances of the University shall be made by the Academic Council which after being approved by the Board of Management, shall be submitted to the State Government for its approval.
- (3) The State Government shall consider the Ordinances submitted under sub-section (2) within two months from the date of their receipt and shall either approve them or give suggestions for modifications therein.
- (4) The Academic Council shall either modify the Ordinances incorporating the suggestion of the State Government or give reasons for not incorporating any of the suggestions made by the State Government and shall return the Ordinances alongwith such reasons, if any, to the State Government and on receipt of the same, the State Government shall consider the comments of the Academic Council and shall approve the Ordinances of the University with or without such modifications.
- 31. Regulations.- The authorities of the University may, subject to the prior approval of the Board of Management, make regulations, consistent with this Act and the rules, Statutes and the Ordinances made thereunder, for the conduct of their own business and that of the committees appointed by them.

32. Admissions.-

- (1) Admission in the University shall be made strictly on the basis of merit.
- (2) Merit for admission in the University may be determined either on the basis of marks or grade obtained in the qualifying examination and achievements in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities or on the basis of marks or grade obtained in the entrance test conducted at the State level either by an association of the universities conducting similar courses or by any agency of the State.

Provided that admission in professional and technical courses shall be made only through entrance test.

(3) Reservation in admission to the University for scheduled castes, scheduled tribes and other backward classes, women and handicapped persons shall be provided as per the policy of the State Government.

33. Fee structure.-

- The University may, from time to time, prepare its fees structure and sent it for approval of the committee constituted for the purpose.
- (2) The committee shall consider the fees structure prepared by the University and if it is satisfied that the proposed fees is
 - (a) sufficient for :-
 - (i) Generating resources for meeting the recurring expenditure of the University; and
 - (ii) the savings required for the further development of the University; and
 - (b) not unreasonably excessive, it may approve the fees structure.
- (3) The fees structure approved by the committee under sub-section (2) shall remain in force for three years and the University shall be entitled to charge fees in accordance with such fees structure.
- (4) The University shall not charge any fees, by whatever name called, other than that for which it is entitled under sub-section(3).
- 34. Examinations.- At the beginning of each academic session and in any case not later than 30th of August of every calendar year, the University shall prepare and publish a schedule of examinations for each and every course conducted by it and shall strictly adhere to the schedule.

Explanation.- "Schedule of Examination" means a table giving details about the time, day and date of the commencement of each paper which is a part of a scheme of examinations and shall also include the details about the practical examinations:

Provided that if, for any reason whatsoever, the University has been unable to follow this schedule, it shall, as soon as practicable, submit a report to the State Government incorporating the reasons for making a departure from the published schedule. The Government may, thereon, issue such directions as it may deem fit for the compliance of the schedule.

35. Declaration of results.-

Provided that if, for any reason whatsoever, the University is unable to finally declare the results of any examination within the aforesaid period of forty-five days, it shall submit a report incorporating the reasons for such delay to the State Government. The State Government may, thereon, issue such directions as it may deem

- No examination or the results of an examination shall be held invalid only for the reasons that the University has not followed the time schedule as stipulated in section 34 or as the case may be, in section 35.
- 36. Convocation.- The convocation of the University shall be held in every academic year in the manner as may be prescribed by the Statutes for conferring degrees, diplomas or for any other purpose.
- Accreditation of the University.- The University shall obtain accreditation 37. from the NAAC, as per the norms of the NAAC and inform the State Government and such other regulating bodies which are connected with the courses taken up by the University about the grade provided by the NAAC to the University. The University shall get renewed such accreditation from time to time as per the norms of the NAAC.
- 38. University to follow rules, regulations, norms etc. of the regulating bodies.- Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, the University shall be bound to comply all the rules, regulations, norms etc. of the regulating bodies and provide all such facilities and assistance to such bodies as are required by them to discharge their duties and carry out their functions.

39. Annual report.-

- (1)The annual report of the University shall be prepared by the Board of management which shall include among other matters, the steps taken by the University towards the fulfilment of its objects and copy of the same shall be submitted to the Sponsoring Body.
- Copies of the annual report prepared under sub-section (1) shall also (2) be presented to the State Government.

40. Annual accounts and audit .-

- (1)The annual accounts including balance sheet of the University shall be prepared under the directions of the Board of Management and the annual accounts shall be audited at least once in every year by the auditors appointed by the University for this purpose.
- A copy of the annual accounts together with the audit report shall (2)be submitted to the Board of Management.

- (3) A copy of the annual accounts and audit report along with the observations of the Board of Management shall be submitted to the Sponsoring Body.
- (4) Copies of annual accounts and balance sheet prepared under subsection (1) shall also be presented to the State Government. The advice of the State Government, if any, arising out of the accounts and audit report of the University shall be placed before the Board of Management. The Board of Management shall issue such directions, as it may deem fit and compliance shall be reported to the State Government.

41. Powers of the State Government to inspect the University.-


- (1) For the purpose of ascertaining the standards of teaching, examination and research or any other matter relating to the University, the State Government may cause an inspection, to be made in such manner as may be prescribed, by such person or persons as it may deem fit.
- (2) The State Government shall communicate to the University its recommendations in regard to the result of such inspection for corrective action. The University shall adopt such corrective measures and make efforts so as to ensure the compliance of the recommendations.
- (3) If the University has failed to comply with the recommendations made under sub-section (2) within a reasonable time, the State Government may give such directions as it may deem fit for such compliance.

42. Powers of the State Government to call for information.-

- (1) The State Government may call for information from the University relating to its working, functions, achievements, standard of teaching, examination and research or any other matters as it may consider necessary to judge the efficiency of the University in such form and within such time as may be prescribed by rules.
- (2) The University shall be bound to furnish the information as required by the State Government under sub-section (1) within the prescribed time.

43. Dissolution of the University by the Sponsoring Body.-

(1) The Sponsoring Body may dissolve the University by giving a notice to the effect in the prescribed manner to the State Government and the employees and the students of University at least one year in advance:

Provided that dissolution of the University shall have effect only after the approval of the State Government and the last batches of students of the regular courses have completed their courses and they have been awarded degrees, diplomas or awards, as the case may be.

On the dissolution of the University all the assets and liabilities of the University shall vest in the Sponsoring Body.

Special powers of the State Government in Certain Circumstances.-

- (1) If it appears to the State Government that the University has contravened any of the provisions of this Act or the rules, Statutes or Ordinances made thereunder or has violated any of the directions issued by it under this Act or has ceased to carryout any undertakings given by it to the State Government or a situation of financial mismanagement or mal-administration has arisen in the University, it shall issue notice requiring the University to show cause within fortyfive days as to why an order of its liquidation should not be made.
- (2) If the State Government, on receipt of reply of the University on the notice issued under sub-section (1), is satisfied that there is a prima facie case of contravening any of the provisions of this Act or the rules, Statutes or Ordinances made thereunder or of violating directions issued by it under this Act or of ceasing to carryout the undertakings given by it or of financial mismanagement or maladministration, it shall make an order of such enquiry as it may consider necessary.
- (3) The State Government shall, for the purposes of any enquiry under sub- section (2), appoint an inquiry officer or officers to inquire into any of the allegations and to make report thereon.
- (4) The inquiry officer or officers appointed under sub-section (3) shall have the same powers as are vested in a civil court under the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (Central Act No. 5 of 1908) while trying a suit in respect of the following matters, namely:
 - summoning and enforcing the attendance of any person and examining him on oath;
 - (b) requiring the discovery and production of any such document or any other material as may be predicable in evidence; and
 - requisitioning any public record from any court or office. (c)
- The inquiry officer or officers inquiring under this Act shall be (5)deemed to be a civil court for the purposes of section 195 and Chapter 26 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Central Act No. 2 of 1974).



- On receipt of the enquiry report from the officer or officers appointed under sub-section (3), if the State Government is satisfied that the University has contravened any of the provisions of this Act or the rules, Statutes or Ordinances made thereunder or has violated any of the directions issued by it under this Act or has ceased to carryout the undertakings given by it or a situation of financial mismanagement and mal-administration has arisen in the University which threatens the academic standard of the University, it shall make orders for liquidation of the University and appoint an administrator and thereupon the authorities and officers of the University shall be subject to the order and direction of the administrator.
- (7) The administrator appointed under sub-section (6) shall have all the powers and be subject to all the duties of the Board of Management under this Act and shall administer the affairs of the University until the last batch of the students of the regular courses have completed their courses and they have been awarded degrees, diplomas or awards as the case may be.
- (8) After having been awarded the degrees, diplomas or awards, as the case may be, to the last batches of the students of the regular courses, the administrator shall make a report to the effect to the State Government.
- (9) On receipt of the report under sub-section (8), the State Government shall, by a notification in the Official Gazette, issue an order dissolving the University and from the date of publication of such notification the University shall stand dissolved and all the assets and liabilities of the University shall vest in the Sponsoring Body from such date.

45. Powers to make rules .-

- (1) The State Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, make rules to carry out the purposes of this Act.
- (2) All rules made under this Act shall be laid, as soon as may be, after they are so made, before the House of the State Legislature, while it is in session, for a period of not less than fourteen days which may be comprised in one session or in two successive sessions and if before the expiry of the session in which they are so laid or of the session immediately following, the House of the State Legislature makes any modification in any such rules or resolves that any such rules should not be made, such rules shall thereafter have effect only in such modified form or be of no effect, as the case may be, so

however, that any such modification or annulment shall be without prejudice to the validity of anything previously done thereunder.

46. Powers to remove difficulties.-

- (1) If any difficulty arises in giving effect to the provisions of this Act, the State Government may, by order published in the Official Gazette. make provisions, not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, as appear to it to be necessary or expedient for removing the difficulty: Provided that no order under this section shall be made after the expiry of a period of two years from the date of commencement of this Act.
- (2) Every order made under this section shall, as soon as may be after it is made, shall be laid before the House of the State Legislature.
- 47. The Act to have over riding effect.- The provisions of this Act and the rules, Statutes, Ordinances made thereunder shall have effect notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in any other law, for the time being in force, relating to the matters in respect of which the State Legislature has exclusive power to make laws.





STATUTES OF THE JAGAN NATH UNIVERSITY, JAIPUR, 2011

In exercise of the power conferred by sub-section (1) and (2) of section 29 of the Jagan Nath University Jaipur Act, 2008 (Act No. 19 of 2008); the Board of Management of the Jagan Nath University Jaipur, hereby makes the following

APPOINTMENTS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE, POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF THE OFFICERS AND OTHER FUNCTIONARIES OF THE UNIVERSITY

- 7. Appointment of the Chairperson. (1) The Chairperson of the University shall be appointed in accordance with the provisions of section 12 of the Act.
- (2) The Chairperson shall perform his duties in an honorary capacity. However, he/she may be paid such honorarium not less than the salary of the President and all other terms and conditions of service shall be as applicable to the President.
- 8. Powers and Functions of the Chairperson. (1) In addition to powers specified in section 12 of the Act, the Chairperson shall have the following powers and functions, namely:-

PRESIDENT

- Appointment of the President. (1) The President shall be appointed in accordance with section 13 of the Act.
- (2) The President to be appointed should be a distinguished academician, with a minimum of 10 years experience as Professor in a University system or 10 years experience in an equivalent position in a reputed research, industrial or administrative organization.
- (3) Whenever the office of the president falls vacant for any reason other than the expiry of the first term of appointment of the incumbent, the Board of Management may in the interest of the university, assign the responsibilities of the President to the Pro-President, until a suitable person, appointed as the President, assumes office as such.
- 10. Powers and Functions of the President. (1) The President being the Principal Executive and Academic Officer of the University, in addition to the powers and functions specified in section 13 the Act, shall have the following powers and functions, namely:
 - exercise general supervision and control over the affairs of the University including its academic programmes, research, faculty, staff, students, business and external affairs, giving effect to the decisions of all the Authorities of the University in letter and spirit, and ensuring that they are not contradictory in nature and practice;
 - (ii) preside over the convocation of the University in the absence of the Chairperson;
 - (iii) faithfully observe and follow the provisions of the Act, the Statutes and the Ordinances, and shall, without prejudice, to the powers of the Chairperson, possess all such power as may be necessary on that behalf; and

- (iv) delegate such powers as deemed necessary, to any other officer of the University, with the approval of the Chairperson.
- (2) The President shall have the powers to make ad-hoc appointments for a period not exceeding one year, of such persons, as may be considered necessary for functioning of the University with prior approval of the Chairperson.
- (3) The President shall be empowered to grant leave to any officer of the University and make necessary arrangements for the discharge of the functions of such an officer during the period of absence of such officer.
- (4) If the office of the President becomes vacant due to death, resignation or otherwise, or if he is unable to perform his duties due to ill health or any other reason, the Pro-President shall perform the duties of the President, until the vacancy is filled up under the provisions of the Act and the Statutes and Ordinances enumerated there under.

11. Appointment, powers and functions of the Pro-President.— (1) The Pro-President shall be appointed by the Chairperson in accordance with the provisions of section 14 of the Act.

- (3) The Provost may hold special or general inquiries into any situations involving the conduct of any employee causing or likely to cause breach of the peace and order in the University
- (4) The Provost shall exercise such other powers and perform such other duties as may be prescribed by the Chairperson/President from time to time.
- (5) If the President is satisfied, on an enquiry made or daused to be made on a representation made to him or otherwise, that the continuance of Provost in his office is prejudicial to the interest of the University or the situation so warrants, he may, by

perform such other functions, as may be entrusted to them by the President.

- (4) When the office of a Dean is vacant or where the Dean is unable to perform his duties due to illness, absence or any other reason, the President may authorize any other senior most Professor to perform the functions of the Dean during such period.
- (5) The Dean may formulate policies and development programs for improving academic standards of his faculty and present them to the appropriate authorities of the University for their consideration. He may also eall for meetings of the faculty in consultation with President and may preside over them.

REGISTRAR

15. Appointment.—(1) The Registrar shall be appointed by the Chairperson in accordance with section 18 of the Act and shall be a salaried officer of the University.

- (ii) have a administrative experience of at least 10 years; and

- (2) Each Committee so appointed, will deal only with the subject assigned to it, and its recommendations, on or about such subject, may be considered, subject to confirmation by the body, which has appointed it.

If the time is not extended than such authority/committee will be abolished automatically. However the appointing body may remove/abolish such authority/committee at any time at its discretion.

CHAPTER-5

APPOINTMENT OF TEACHERS, OFFICERS AND OTHER EMPLOYEES OF THE UNIVERSITY

- 20. Teachers of the University.— (1) Teachers of the University shall consist of two categories, namely:
 - (i) Appointed teachers of the University; and
 - (ii) Recognized teachers of the University.
- (2) Appointed teachers of the University shall be either:
- (i) Employees of the University as Professors,
 Associate Professors/Assistant Professors and

- (4) No person shall be appointed or recognized as a teacher of the University except on the recommendation of a Selection Committee constituted for the purpose.
- (5) The qualifications of recognized teachers of the University should be such as may be prescribed by the University Grants Commission.
- (6) All applications or such other particulars, as may be provided from time to time in accordance with the Act, the Statutes and Ordinances there under, for the recognition of teachers of the University, shall be made in such a manner as may be laid down by the Board of Management.
- 21. Terms and Conditions of appointment of Teachers, Officers and other employees.—(1) Every teacher and salaried officer and such other employees as are mentioned in the Statutes shall be appointed under a written contract on such terms and conditions as may be agreed to between the parties which shall be lodged with the University, and a copy thereof shall be furnished to the officer or teacher or employee concerned.
- (2) Any dispute arising out of a contract between the University and those specified in sub-clause (1) above shall, at the request of the teacher or officer or employee concerned, or at the instance of the University be referred to a Committee consisting of one member appointed by the Academic Council, one member from amongst the staff and an umpire appointed by the Chairperson. The decision of the Committee shall be final.
- (3) All posts in the University shall normally be filled by advertisement, however the Chairperson shall have the power to decide, on the recommendation being made by the President in this regard, that a particular post be filled by invitation or by contractual appointment or by promotion from amongst the members of the staff of the University.
- (4) The Selection Committees, so being constituted for filling the post in the University (other than the post on contract basis), by advertisement or by promotion from amongst the members of the staff of the University, shall be constituted in the manner laid down in the Statutes.

22. Removal of Teachers. (1) A teacher may be senseled under the following circumstances:

- (i) Where there is an allegation of misconduct against a teacher, the President may, if he thinks fit and by an order in writing, remove that teacher from his post and report the matter to the Board of Management for approval;
- (ii)Where there is documentary evidence that the teacher is not performing academic duties properly as per the standards laid down by the University; and

(iii) Where it is found, that the teacher is:-

- (a) of unsound mind:
- (b) an undischarged insolvent; or
- (c) convicted by a court of law of any criminal offence or an offence involving moral turpitude:
- (d) He/she is otherwise guilty of misconduct; and
- (e) He/she does not meet the performance standards established by the performance evaluation system of the University.

(2) No teacher shall be removed under sub-clause (1) until he has been given a reasonable opportunity of being heard:

Provided that where a teacher is under suspension at the time of his/her removal, the removal shall take effect on the date on which he/she was placed under suspension.

- (3) Notwithstanding anything contained in these Statutes, a teacher shall be entitled to resign by giving three months notice in writing to the Registrar or in lieu thereof by making payment of three month's salary to the Registrar.
- 23. Removal of employees other than a teacher. (1) An employee of the University, other than a teacher, may be removed by the Authority which was competent to appoint the employee according to the procedure laid down by the Board of Management, if,—

CONVOCATION

- 25. Convocation. (1) A Convocation for conferring the degrees, diplomas and other academic distinctions may be held by the University not more than once in a year on such date as Academic Council may decide.

- (3) The procedure to be observed at the convocation and other matters connected therewith shall be such as may be laid down in the Ordinances of the University.
- (4) Where the University, does not find it convenient to hold the convocation in accordance with Statutes, the degrees, diplomas and other academic distinctions may be dispatched to the candidates concerned by registered post.

CHAPTER - 7

MISCELLANEOUS Roll of Tracking and Artificial Policy (1)

- 26. Elected Chairman to preside where no provision is made in the Statutes.— If the Act, the Statutes or the rules of the University do not provide for a Chairman to preside over the meetings of any Authority of Committee of the University, or when its Chairman is absent, its members present shall elect one among themselves to preside at the meetings.
- 27. Resignation and Superannuation.— (1) Any member other than an ex-officio member of the Academic Council, the Finance Committee or any other Authority of the University or Committee may resign by a letter addressed to the Registrar, and the resignation shall take effect as soon as the letter is received by the Registrar.

(2) Any officer of the University (whether saladores otherwise) may resign his office by a letter addressed to the Registrar, as provided in the terms of his appointment.

Provided that such resignation shall take effect only on the date from which the said letter is accepted by the Authority competent to fill the vacancy.

- (3) All administrative employees of the University, except those on contract, shall retire on attaining the age of 60 years.
- 28. Disqualifications. (1) A person shall be disqualified, who is so chosen and elected to be a member of any of the authorities/bodies of the University and be removed from such bodies/authorities in the following circumstances:-
 - (a) he is found to be of unsound mind;
 - (b)he is found to be an un discharged insolvent:
 - (c) he has been convicted by a court of law of any criminal offence or an offence involving moral turpitude; and
 - (d) he is otherwise guilty of proved misconduct.
- (2) If any question arises as to whether a person is or had been subjected to any of the disqualifications mentioned in clause (1), the question shall be referred for the decision of the Chairperson and his decision thereupon shall be final.
- 29. Honorary Degrees.—Any proposal for the conferment of an honorary degree or distinction shall be made by the Academic Council to the Board of Management and shall require the approval of the Chairperson before confirmation.
- 30. Withdrawal of Degrees.—The Academic Council may, by a special resolution passed by a majority of not less than two-third of the members present and voting, withdraw any degree or academic distinction conferred on or any certificate or diploma granted to any person by the University:

- 31. Maintenance of discipline among Students. (1) All powers relating to discipline and disciplinary action concerning the students shall vest in the Provost.




